








MINUTES OF ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 26.11.2024

Minutes of meeting

Dr. Sanu Tom Abraham, Principal, welcomed the gathering and briefed us on the meeting minutes.

1. Collaboration with Mahsa University, Malaysia

Principal informed that our institution is in the process of collaborating with Mahsa University, Malaysia. The Vice Principal Dr. Eldho T Paul, further detailed regarding the collaboration initiatives. The collaboration includes an 'Intern Mobility Program' which includes a 2-week program for interns at Mahsa University, Malaysia, scheduled to be held in February 2025. The program also includes enabling the participation of the students in the upcoming International Conference, scheduled in the month of February at the University. The Principal informed that the Dental Education Unit of our institution shall be entrusted as a 'selection committee' to select the eligible interns following a formal interview and screening as the program is limited to about 15 participants. The selected students, during the program, shall undergo comprehensive training which includes exposure and hands-on training on the latest advancements in dentistry. With the conference participation planned during their visit, the HoD's were requested to guide the selected students with scientific paper presentations. Dr. Eldho further added that talks are going on with the University for possible research collaboration and conduct of certificate/fellowship courses, as a joint venture, to be included as a part of the collaboration. The Principal further informed that an orientation session for interns has been planned later in the day regarding the same.

2. Implant course

The Principal informed that our institution is planning to start a certificate course in Implant dentistry. As a pilot phase, the course will be commencing in January 2025, for the interns of our institution. Dr. Bijoy John, Dean, Student Affairs mentioned that the course will be organised by the Department of Implantology under Dr. Bijoy John and Dr. Miriam Mathew, with the team comprising of the following faculty - Dr. Joju George from the Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, Dr. Shabil Mohamed Mustafa from the Department of Oral Medicine and

shall include placement of a minimum of 10 implants. Talks are in progress with Dentium company for the support for the course. The pilot phase on interns include lectures and hands-on activities.

3. Faculty Development Program

A faculty development program, as per the guidelines of the KUHS, has been proposed to be held on the 18th, 19th, and 20th of December 2024. As per the instructions from the University, the program shall be conducted on three consecutive days for 20-30 participants as the first phase. Three faculty members from our institution, Dr. Subramaniam R, Dr. Ajay P Joseph and Dr. S. Mohamed Mustafa, who have undergone a training at KUHS, will be the resource persons. The program shall be attended by an external observer, appointed by the University. The dates shall be confirmed upon the receiving an approval of the schedule and dates sent to University. All HoDs were instructed to depute 2 faculty members each, from the dental departments and 1 faculty each from the non-dental sciences to attend the sessions.

4. Question Bank

The Principal acknowledged the receipt of complied University exam question papers from all the departments and mentioned that it would be better to extract and segregate the questions based on the question type and the topics for the benefit of students. The Principal appreciated the efforts by the Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery for providing segregated list of questions.

5. Articles for college journal

The Principal requested all the HoD's to encourage their department faculty to contribute manuscripts for the pending issue of the institutional scientific journal. A suggestion was made to collaborate with nearby colleges for procuring scientific manuscripts.

6. Student discipline in campus

The Principal instructed all HoDs to direct all staff to be vigilant in enforcing student and intern discipline in the campus. The HoD's shall take strict action in case of lapses in discipline.
